### c. The future of SenSommerFest (See appendix)

- i. Yes, we want the SSF to be held next year.
- ii. There's usually a negative atmosphere about planning the party and the future of it is therefore uncertain.
- iii. Should S-huset take over some parts of the planning of the party?
  - **1.** Yes. They're more experienced regarding large parties and they could therefore be a big help to the steering group.
  - 2. S-huset already do a lot of the tasks.
- iv. Should we set aside more money for volunteer care?
  - Probably not for cleaning as breakfast and lunch is already provided.
  - We think that the volunteers are cared for but it needs to be more structured and better communicated.
  - **3.** We would like some more clear guidelines regarding the cleaning and whether it's allowed to empty the kegs or not.
  - However, it would be nice with some perks of being a volunteer at the pary,
    - a. Possibly a dinner for the tent steering committee.



- We would like for the information about the different shifts (bar, tent etc.) to be communicated out to us earlier.
- v. How do we change the rhetoric about the party?
  - Be better at communicating information in good time and try to brand it as something nice (not mandatory). Then there might be a more relaxed atmosphere about the party.
  - The last few years there's been a lot of negative talk about the party and a focus on what went wrong. We'd like a bigger focus on the good things and experiences.
  - It seems like the negative atmosphere originate in the steering group and is transferred to the other volunteers. The people attending the party are generally much more positive.
  - **4.** It might be a solution to skip the dinner. It might also make things easier for the steering group.
    - A difference of opinion in the council. Some would like for the dinner to work similar to Rusjoint, whereas others think that the joint dinner in the tents is what makes SSF special.
  - 5. Internal in the steering group:
    - a. The internal communication has been insufficient.
    - Better communication could create a better defined frame for the work of the volunteers.
    - c. We'd prefer for the steering group to be more positive when communicating.
    - It might be a good idea with some "new blood" in the next steering group.
  - 6. The rushers would like some more information about the party.
    - However, it might be difficult as it's described and tickets are sold on their first day of school.



There's a lot of focus on the negative things.
We'd like a more proactive solution, where the steering group is relieved of some tasks.
This could be with the help from S-huset or CAS.
